DAY ONE MONDAY CALGARY BANFF

In route enjoy lunch at legendary Boundary Ranch in the Kananskis Valley, abundant with wild life and stunning views. Continue your tour to Banff. The rest of the day is at your own leisure. DAY TWO TUESDAY LAKE LOUISE

We will begin our day of sightseeing by visiting the charming town of Banff, a UNESCO World Heritage Site in the heart of the Canadian Rockies. We will ride to the summit of Sulphur Mountain aboard the Banff Gondola for breathtaking views of snow-capped peaks and valleys. Visit Yoho National Park in route to Lake Louise. Check into the elegant Fairmont Lake Louise Chateau. (B)

DAY THREE WEDNESDAY JASPER

Today motor along the unforgettable Icefield Parkway and witness amazing scenery including North America's largest sub-polar ice pack. At Athabasca Glacier, climb aboard a specially-designed Ice Explorer for a once-in-a-lifetime guided tour over steep grades, snow and ice as you ascend partway up the glacier. Lunch (on your own) will be available at the lodge. As we continue to Jasper enjoy an alpine wonderland of immense forests, jeweled lakes, soaring waterfalls, rugged glaciers, colorful meadows and majestic mountains. Arrive Jasper and check into the Sawridge Hotel in time for dinner. (B D)

DAY FOUR THURSDAY KAMLOOPS

Travel onboard the Rocky Mountaineer from Jasper in the Canadian Rockies to Kamloops, in the heart of British Columbia's interior. As you journey west and south you will be surrounded by the dramatic scenery of the Continental Divide and by the river valleys of the Monashee and Caribou mountains. Today's highlights include Mount Robson, Pyramid Falls, the climb over Yellowhead Pass and the journey along the North Thompson River as you approach Kamloops. Dinner at "Rhythms on the Rails." (B L D)

DAY FIVE FRIDAY VANCOUVER

Our journey continues west towards the Pacific Ocean and the coastal city of Vancouver. On today's journey we will again see dramatic changes in scenery, from the desert-like environment of the interior, through winding river canyons and pristine forests, to the Coast and Cascade mountains and the lush green fields of the Fraser River Valley. Highlights include the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River and the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon. Arrive in Vancouver in late afternoon. Evening is free in Vancouver. (B L)

DAY SIX SATURDAY VANCOUVER IRVING

Our tour concludes today. Following breakfast we will transfer to the airport or take optional tour of Vancouver or Victoria. (B)
